All participants are required to check-in at the registration desk prior to beginning their walk.

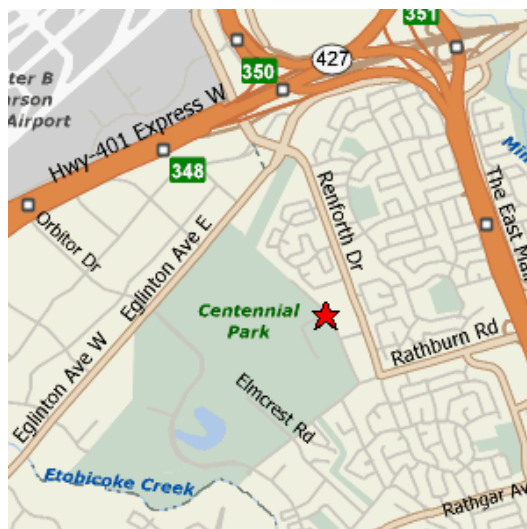
11:30 am Check-in opens
